The goal of this course is to train individuals to respond to a potential or actual hazardous materials incident at a specific workplace for the purposes of stopping the release. This course complies with 29CFR1910.120 and 8CCR5192 regulations. The course uses lectures, tabletop exercises, group activities, and field exercises.

- Regulatory overview
- Emergency response planning ICS
- Site control and accepted safety practices
- Medical surveillance program
- Hazard Identification and risk assessment
- Respiratory protection
- Hazmat confined space considerations
- Rescue considerations
- Chemical protective clothing
- Monitoring and detection equipment
- Decontamination
- Site safety plans
- Offensive and defensive control options
- Incident termination
